Chapter2. Introduction

PDF-Pro is the best mobile PDF reader for iPhone & iPod touch that can be downloaded from Apple AppStore anywhere in the world.

Since it is built on a powerful and proven PDF engine, not only can it view documents beautifully but it can also read double byte character languages such as Korean, Japanese and Chinese as well as single byte character languages such as English.

Since it supports the password input window, if you know the correct password, you can always open the encrypted PDF document with ease and you can also lock the default autorotation function provided by iPhone or iPod touch to prevent unnecessary oscillation of PDF document to view PDF document at ease.

1. Main Features

✓ **Powerful PDF Reader**

Due to its powerful PDF engine developed by ePapyrus, Inc., PDF-Pro lets users read PDF documents fast and easy.

✓ **Support double byte PDF documents that can be used anywhere in the world**

In addition to viewing single byte character PDF documents such as in English, users can also read double byte character PDF documents in Korean, Japanese or Chinese seamlessly.

✓ **Provide a bookmark function which is critical for viewing a PDF document with significant number of pages**

It supports the functions like bookmark creation, bookmark viewing and table of contents viewing to help users search large volume of text effortlessly.

Chapter3. Downloading PDF-Pro

PDF-Pro can be downloaded from iTunes on a PC or AppStore within iPhone/iPod touch.

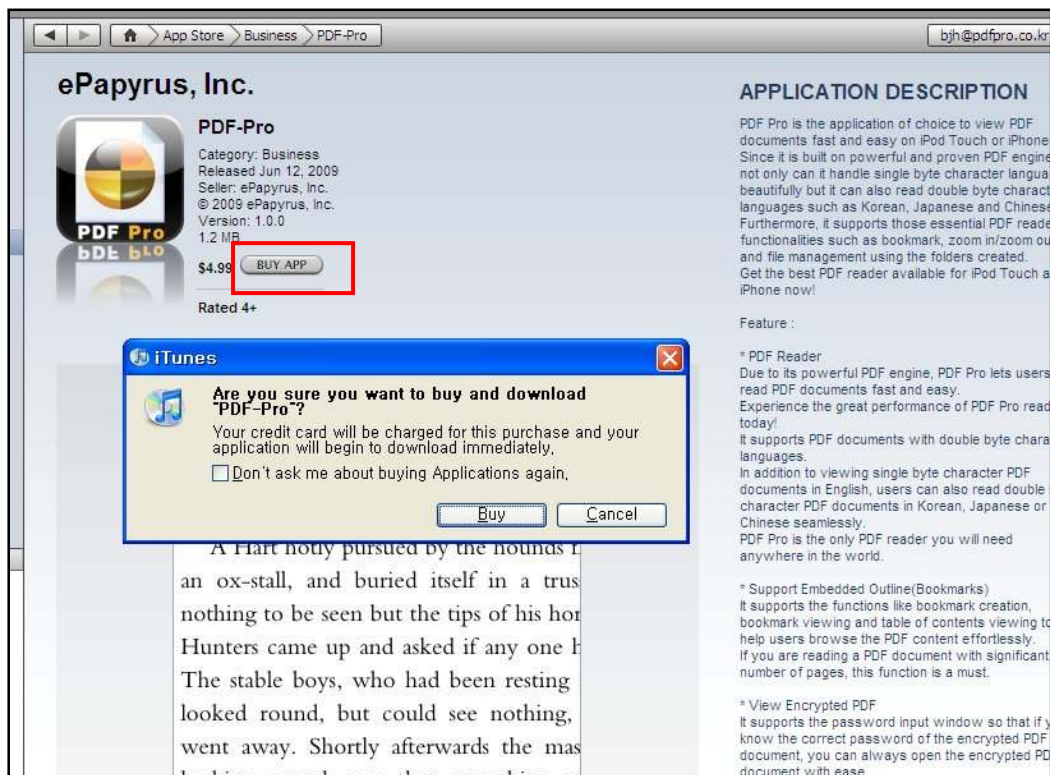
1. From iTunes on a PC

- ① Download iTunes application from the below link.

- ② After you open iTunes, type 'PDF Pro' or 'ePapyrus' in the search field at the top right corner of the window.
- ③ You can download the PDF-Pro by clicking 'BUY APP' tab next to the product description.

- ④ Download to iPhone/iPod touch will be automatically synchronized when the device and PC are connected and you can check the download result by using Store>Download or Device>Application menu on the left.

2. From AppStore within iPhone & iPod touch

- ① Before downloading a file, make sure your device is connected to Wi-Fi. If your device is not connected to Wi-Fi, turn Wi-Fi to 'On' using the 'Settings' menu at the upper left corner of the main page.

- ② After Wi-Fi setting is checked, return to main page and click PDF-Pro icon.
- ③ Enter 'PDF-Pro' in the search field. You can download the PDF-Pro program by clicking 'BUY APP' tab next to the product description.

Chapter 4. How to Use PDF-Pro

1. Downloading a PDF file

A PDF file can be downloaded from a PC or URL.

Before downloading a file, make sure your device is connected to Wi-Fi. If your device is not connected to Wi-Fi, turn Wi-Fi to 'On' using the 'Settings' menu at the upper left corner of the main display. (Figure 3-2)

After Wi-Fi setting is checked, return to main and click PDF-Pro icon.

1) From Desktop PC

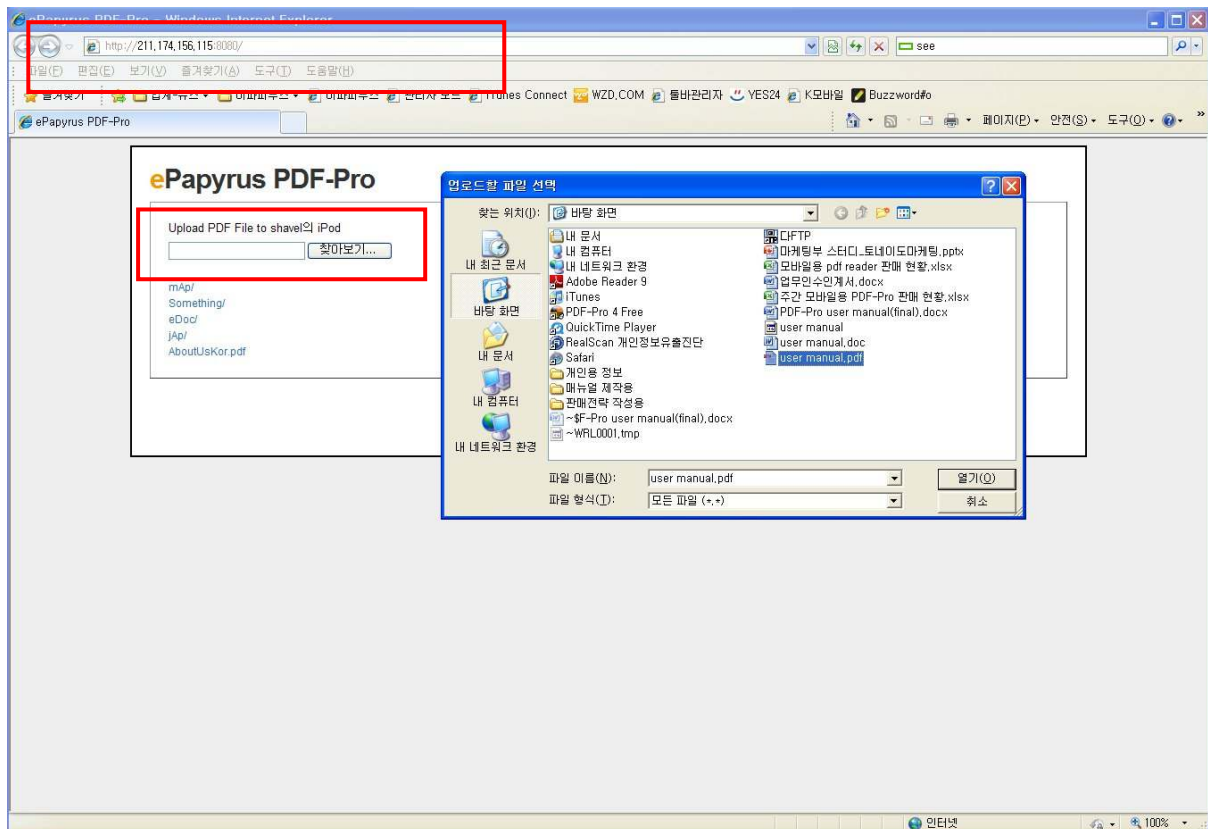
- ① After clicking the 'Download' tab at the lower right corner of the Library list page, choose the 'From Desktop PC' button. After you click the 'From Desktop PC' button, you can see the address for the web browser.

[Figure 4-1] Downloading a file from Desktop PC



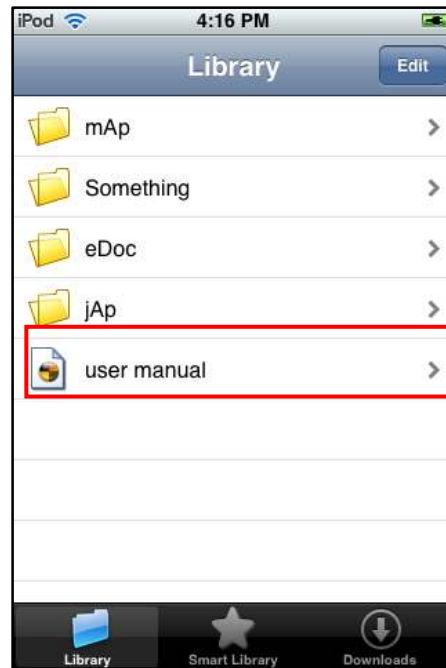
- ② Enter the address you obtained in previous step. Once you are connected to the web address, you will see the list of PDF files in the browser through file upload manager.

- ③ Setup the file to be downloaded to the PC, then click ‘Submit’ to start download.
- ④ Download is complete. You can find the downloaded files in the root directory of the Library.

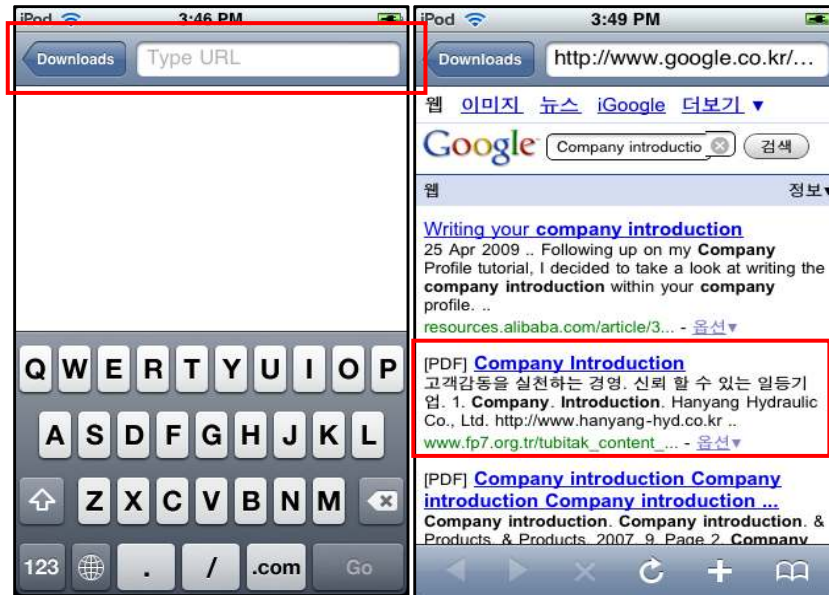
[Figure 4-3] The Downloaded file (Sample)



2) From URL

- ① After clicking the 'Download' tab at the lower right corner of the Library list page, choose the 'From URL' button.
- ② Type the web address in the address field at the upper part of the window and it will move to that page.

- ③ If there is a PDF link on the web page, a popup window asking whether you want to download the file will appear when you click the link.
- ④ If you click 'OK', PDF file will start to download. You can cancel the download at any time.

[Figure 4-5] Download Popup Window



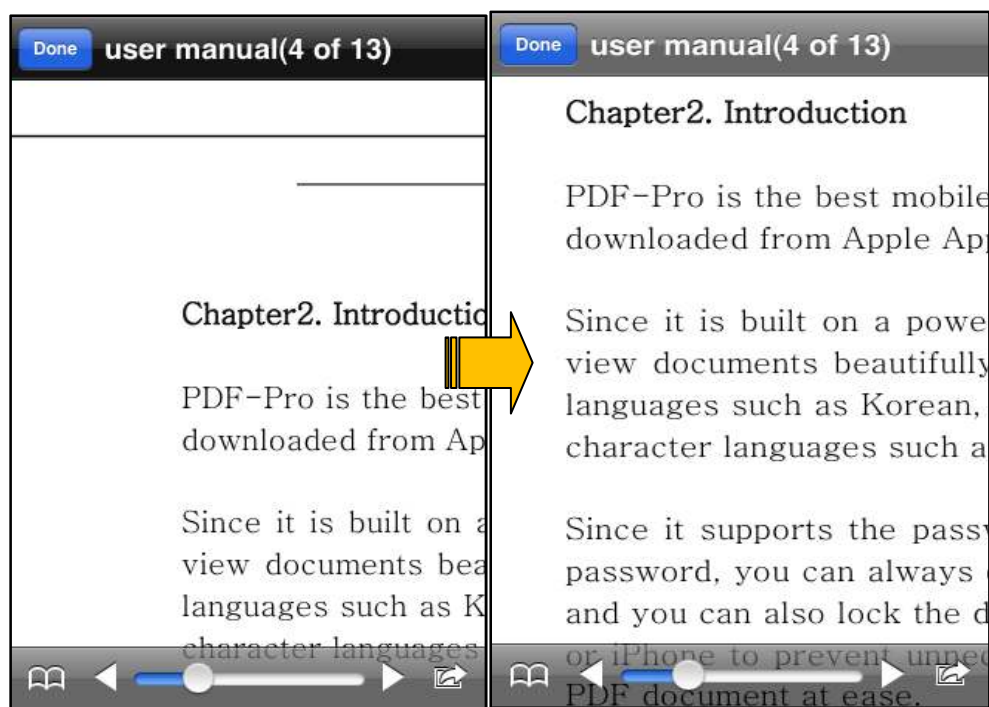
- ⑤ Download is complete. You can find the downloaded files in the root directory of the Library.

2. Viewing PDF File

1) Viewing a file

- ① Choose the file you want to view from the Library or Smart Library. Use your finger and drag the display to view all the files.

[Figure 4-6] Zoom In/Zoom Out the Document



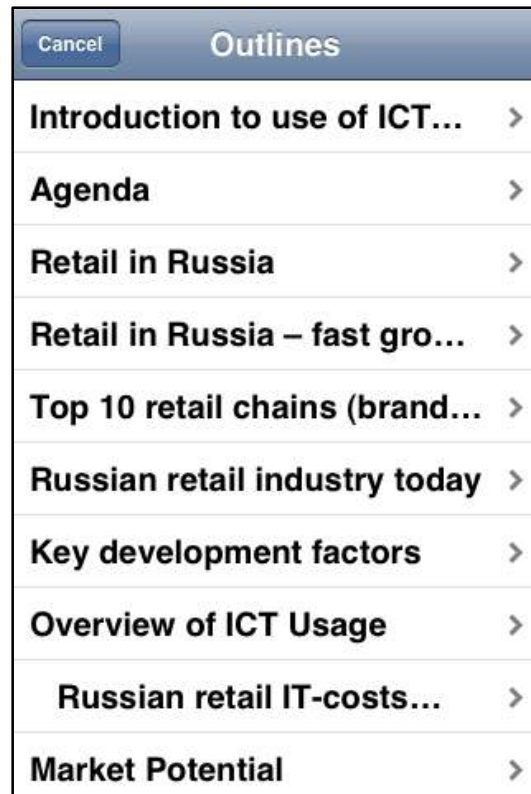
- ② Using two fingers, you can collapse or expand the display to zoom in or zoom out a section of the document you are viewing.

2) Using the Embedded Outline

- ① Users can see the Outlines from the reader if a PDF file has the embedded outline.

- ② While the file is open, choose the 'Bookmark' icon at the lower left corner and click the 'View Outlines' which is the third on the list.

[Figure 4-7] View Outlines



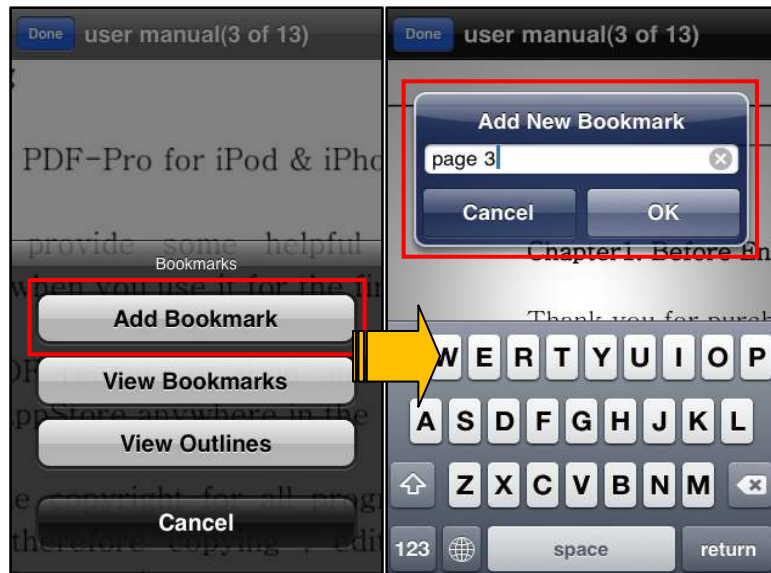
- ③ Choose the part of the list and it will move to that page. If there is a blue button to the right of the list, it means there is a lower level list. Click the blue button and you can see the lower level list.
- ④ Not all PDF files have Outline. Even if there is no Outline, user defined bookmark can be used.

3) Using User Defined Bookmark

- ① While the file is open, choose the 'bookmark' icon at the lower left corner.

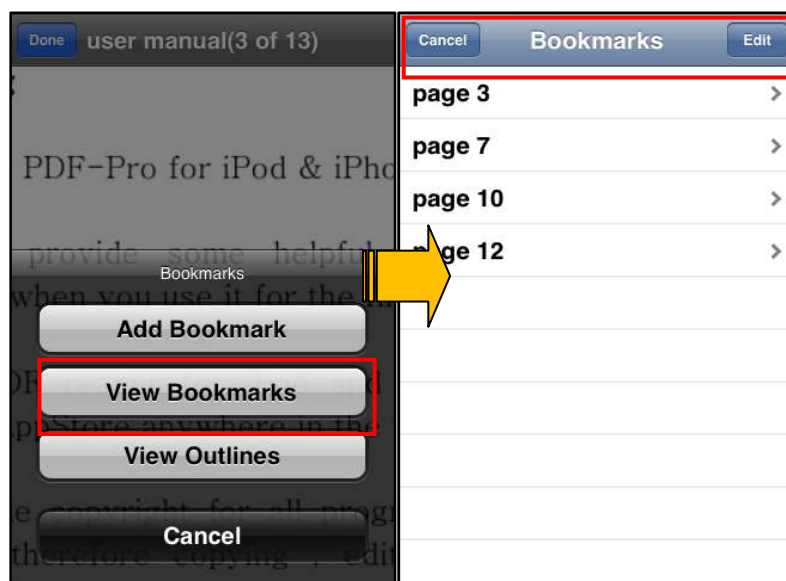
- ② Using the first menu, add the bookmark. After the 'Add Bookmark' menu is selected, type the title and click 'OK'.

- ③ Using the second menu, you can manage the bookmark list. From the bookmark list, you can move to the page by clicking a particular bookmark list. Within the same window, you can delete or change the list of bookmark by using the 'Edit' button on the upper right corner of the window.

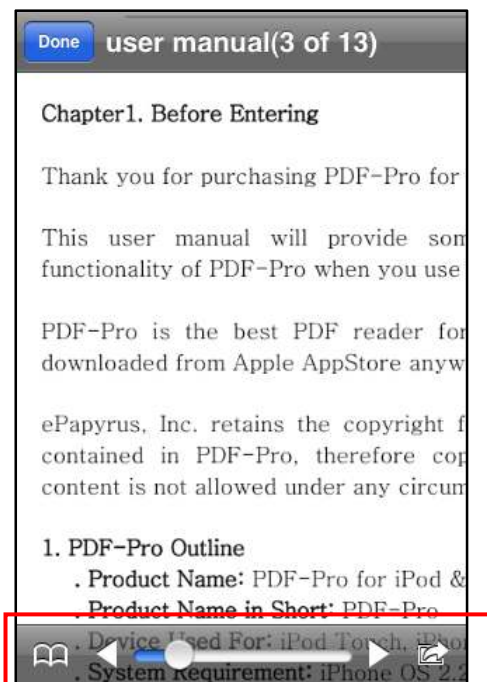
[Figure 4-9]View Bookmark



4) Moving to a page

- ① There are two ways to move to a page, 'Move to previous/next page' or 'Move to a particular page'.
- ② To move to previous/next page, use the arrows at each end of the toolbar.

[Figure 4-10] Moving to a page

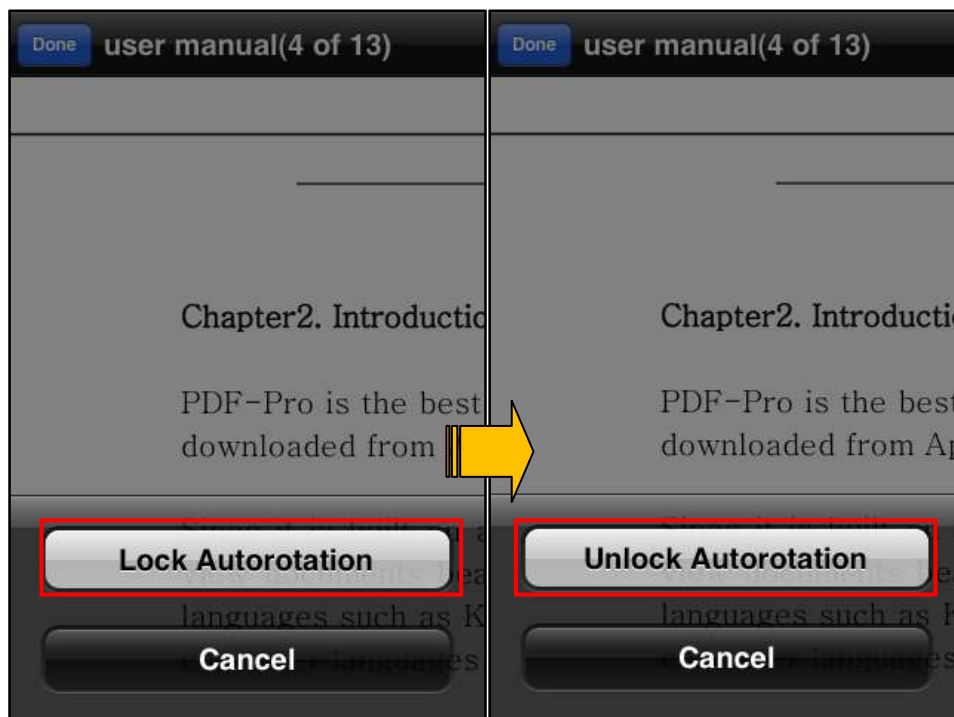


- ③ When you move the page to the end of each side of the screen using the fingers, an arrow appears and when you keep dragging the page until the entire arrow appears, it will move to the previous or next page.
- ④ If you want to move to a particular page, use the slide bar at the middle of the toolbar. As you continue to press the slide bar, the pages will change and you can conveniently move to the page you want.

5) Autorotation/Lock Autorotation

- ① As you tilt the iPhone or iPod touch, the display will automatically rotate to the direction of the tilt. Using the landscape mode of the display, user can view bigger part of the sentence structure.
- ② In some cases, auto-rotation function of iPhone or iPod touch over-reacts to the tilt and gives wrong result than intended. To avoid this shortcoming, you can lock autorotation function.

[Figure 4-11] Lock/Unlock Autorotation

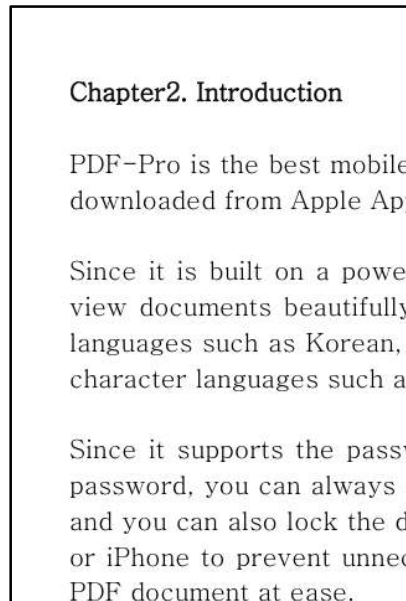


- ③ After you touch the 'Action' button to the right of the toolbar, choose the 'Lock Autorotation' to turn off the autorotation function. To activate the autorotation again, touch the 'Action' button then choose 'Unlock Autorotation'.

6) Hiding the Toolbar

- ① Sometimes the toolbar is a hindrance to viewing a file. To hide this toolbar, touch the middle of the document slightly.

[Figure 4-12] Hiding the toolbar

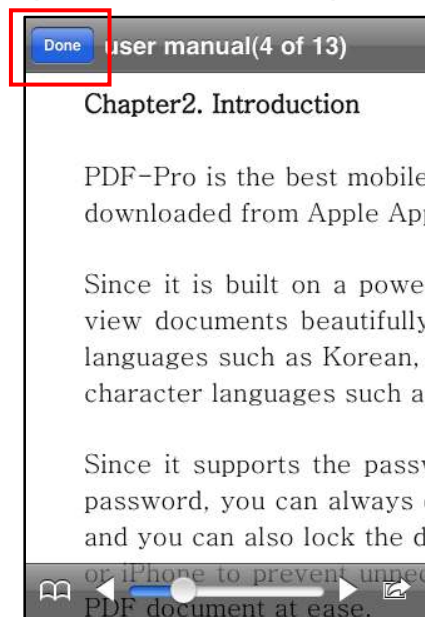


- ② Every time you touch the screen, the toolbar will toggle on and off.

7) Closing the file

- ① While the toolbar is on, press the 'Done' button on the upper left corner of the window.

- ② When you close a PDF file, your device will show either Library or Smart Library window.

3. Using the Library function

1) Creating a folder

- ① Press the 'Edit' button on the upper right corner of the Library window. You will see the 'Add New Folder' menu at the bottom of the list.
- ② After clicking the 'Add New Folder', type the folder name in the input field, then click 'OK'.

[Figure 4-14] Add New Folder

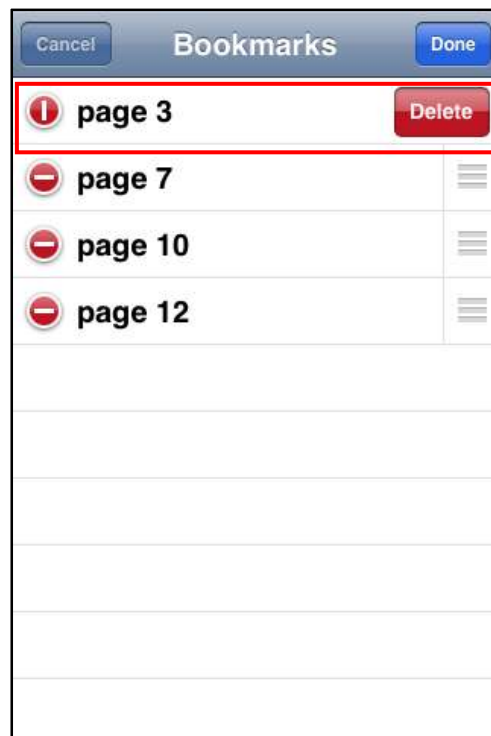


- ③ A new folder has been created. Folders are organized in top down tree format so it can be created in any level of the tree structure.

2) Deleting a file/folder

- ① Press the 'Edit' button on the upper right corner of the Library window. To the left of the file or folder list, a red '-' button appears.
- ② When you click the '-' button, 'Delete' button appears on the right. A file or folder will be deleted when you press the button.

[Figure 4-15] Delete File/Folder



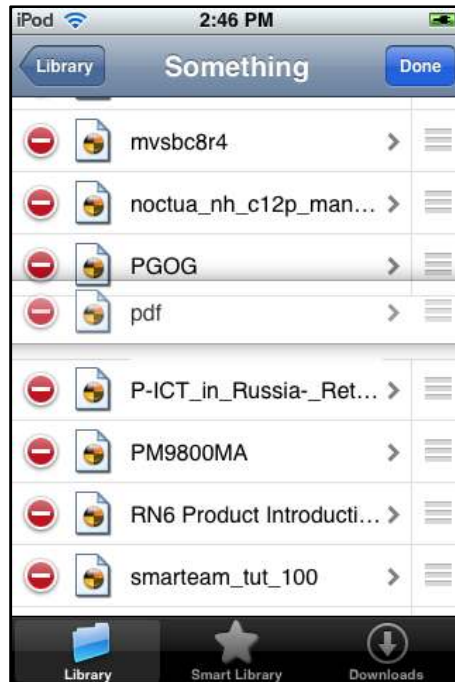
- ③ When deleting a folder, be careful since any file or folder inside the same folder will also be deleted.

3) Changing the order of file/folder

- ① Press the 'Edit' button on the upper right corner of the Library window. To the right of the file or folder list, a 'drag' button appears that will let you change the order.

- ② While pressing the 'drag' button, drag the file or folder to the location you want to move it to.

- ③ The file or folder order has been changed.

4) Changing the name or the location of a file/folder

- ① Press the 'Edit' button on the upper right corner of the Library window. Choose the file or folder that you want to change the name or the location. From the selected window, you can change the name or the location.
- ② In the first section, the name of the file/folder can be changed. After typing the new name, press the 'Done' button at the upper left corner of the window.
- ③ In the second section, the current location of the file/folder appears. When you choose a file or folder, the entire tree

structure of the folder will appear. When you click the new location of the folder you want, the file or folder you chose will move to that new location.

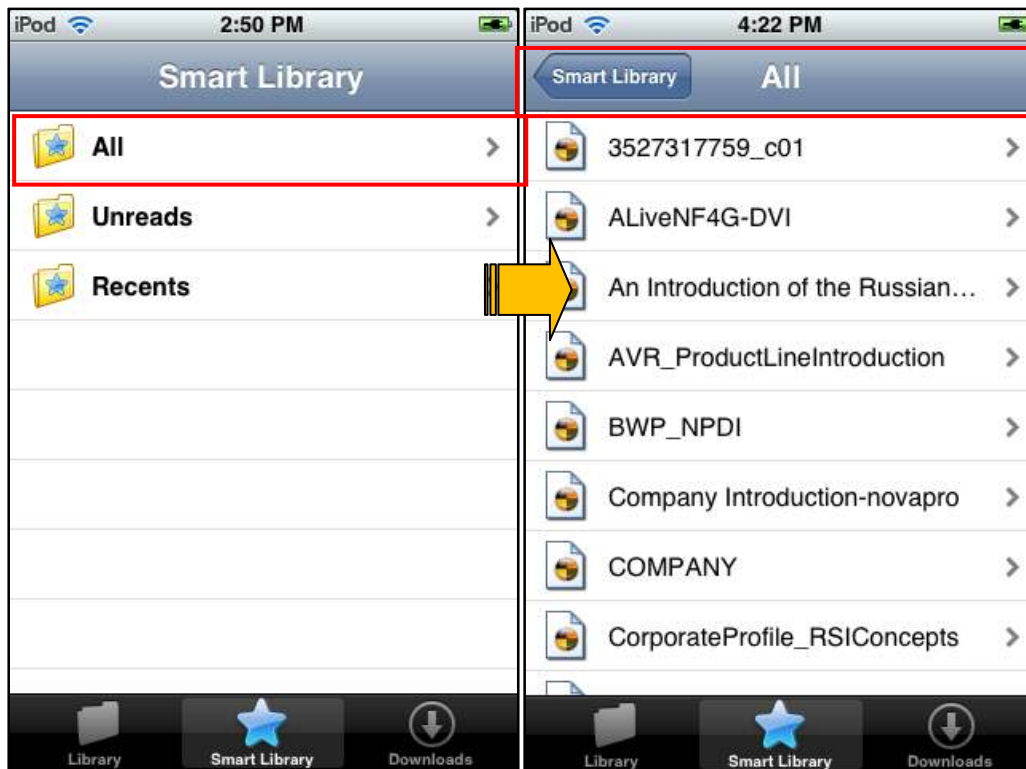
- ④ The name and the location of the file/folder have been changed.

4. Using the Smart Library function

1) Viewing all files

- ① After pressing the Smart Library tab, choose the 'All'.

- ② It will list all the files that were downloaded or opened.

2) Viewing unread files

- ① After pressing the Smart Library tab, choose the 'Unreads'.

- ② It will list the files that were never opened after being downloaded from a PC or the web.

3) Viewing recent files

- ① After pressing the Smart Library tab, choose the 'Recents'.

- ② It will only list the recently opened files in the order of most recent file first.
